Spanish R&D investment situation

Spanish R&D investment situation

99% Spanish industry are SMEs: 1.180.000 enterprises

Around **54%** of the protection of R&D results is made by the **private sector**.

The European technology protection average is between **80%-90%** for the private sector. The rest is made by Universities and Public Research Centers.

There are no relation between Spanish economical position and protection of R&D

SPTO has the commitment to implement activities, measures and policies to approach IP knowledge to SMEs in order to incorporate IP into their corporate culture. That will enable new ways of business and refunding investment in R&D



Reduction of fees

E-Filing

- 15% reduction on fees when applying on-line.
- In new Patent Law Draft up to 50% to SME and Enterpreneurs (application fee, search report fee, examination fee and grant fee).
- SPTO, acting as International Searching Authority under the PCT, is applying a reduction of 75% of the PCT Search fee where the applicant is a national of and resides in a State not party to the European Patent Convention and which is classified by the World Bank in the group of countries of "low income", "lower middle income" or "upper middle income", no matter if the applicant is a natural person or a legal entity.





➤ The Spanish Patent and Trademark Office (SPTO) grant reductions of pre-grant fees, under certain conditions of eligibility, to natural persons, SMEs including micro entities and public universities. There are no specific fee reductions for research institutes.

Subsidy Program

- National promotion
- Spanish patent and utility models



- In case of national promotion for Spanish patents or utility models, only natural persons and SMEs, including micro-entities, are eligible for a subsidy of application and search report fees under the condition that the patent application together with the search report or the utility model application has been published in the SPTO "Official Gazette of Industrial Property" and the fees have been paid in advance.
- The amounts to be subsidized are up to 90% of those fees.



- In the case of international extension the subsidy is addressed to the extension of a patent application or an utility model application via national or regional. The procedures subsidized are: application fee, search report fee, examination fee, grant fee, maintenance fees, European validation, PCT International Search Report fee, PCT International Preliminary Examination fee and a limited amount for translation costs
- The amounts to be subsidized are in general up to 70%, and in the case of SMEs and natural persons up to 80%.



- In case of universities, the average number of patent applications from public universities in the past four years has been 589. In the same years the average value of domestic patent applications has been 3,567. These data imply that public universities represent 16.5% of the number of patent applications in Spain.
- For national patents and utility models subsidies, during the 2012 program, 473 applications were benefited, which represents the 8% of the total number of 5878 national applications. Regarding applicant category, 55% were SMEs and 45% natural persons.
- For international extensions based on national patents and utility models, 3.052 priorities were benefited which represent 7.340 international extensions. This program cover all kind of applicants and it was distributed: SMEs 49,2%, Big companies 18,1%, Natural persons 24,2%, Public Universities 4,3%, Others 4,2%.
